This tutorial provides steps to access the teacher account your school created for you in ELEteca that connects to your email address. Use this new account instead of any demo access you may have received with a demo login.

Go to ELEteca: https://cambridgespanish.edinumen.es

Select Log in.



Enter the email/Username and Password your school provided for the bulk upload of classes, teachers, and students. Then click **Log In**.
