

Similar to duplicating a class, you can also share your created class with other teachers in your program. The teachers must have an account and have activated the same materials you are using. Again, all assign dates, created activities, shown/hidden exercises, and late submission settings will follow into the new class (student enrollment, grades, and additional teachers will not carry over):

1. Select your class in My classes then click on Share class configuration:
